

## Igaliku Country Hotel

Igaliku is one of the most beautiful villages in Greenland. Small stone houses are spread over a protected, green and fertile plain in the head of a very blue fjord. On the other side of the fjord dominates a rough and desolate landscape.

Igaliku Country Hotel gives you the opportunity to experience the life in a Greenlandic village together with high comfort in accommodation and delicious meals.

### Facilities

The country hotel has 8 double rooms with comfortable beds. There are separate showers and toilets in the corridor and a dining room with a beautiful view over the village. Additionally, there are 6 cabins. (Each for two persons. Extra bed in a cabin can be arranged) There are separate showers and toilets in a service cabin close to the other cabins. Everything is newly renovated, and staying here a night or two gives you an extraordinary experience of peace and tranquillity.

### Opening hours

Igaliku Country Hotel is open from May 1st. to October 1st.

### Transfer

Transfer by car to/from Itilleq can be arranged (4 km).

Price: EUR/DKK 9/60 per person (one way) minimum 4 persons.

Transport of luggage: EUR/DKK 9/60 per person (one way) (no minimum).

Transport of luggage to/from the harbour in Igaliku is included.
